

2016 - 2017 Driftless Area Defensive Pistol League – Shoot # 6

The 6th and final shoot of the league season will be held on April 22nd, 2017 at the Pine River Sports Association (PRSA) Indoor Range at Richland Center Wisconsin.

This shoot is open to Sports Clubs, Educational Institutions, Law Enforcement Departments and Individuals.

The entry fee will be \$25.00 for the league season - if you have paid your league fee you are good to go for this shoot and all remaining league shoots for the 2016-17 season. The entry fee for shooters, firing as individuals, is \$5.00, payable at the time of the shoot.

Firing will begin at 9:00am with Team competition. Firing will continue until everyone wishing to do so, has fired. If there is sufficient remaining time, teams wishing to fire a makeup for previous shoots may do so.

As in the November-March shoots, in order to assure fairness and equality, the Team competition will be limited to one Class and one Category.

The class will be "centerfire" utilizing a semi-automatic handgun. The calibers allowed will be 9mm Parabellum, .40 Smith & Wesson and 45 ACP.

The category will be "production" handgun, having open or iron sights only. In other words; a standard off the shelf handgun with sights as provided by the manufacturer, aka, a duty weapon.

There will be no restrictions for anyone firing as individuals in the "unlimited" category.

The shooter will not be required to use the same handgun in all league matches. However, the same handgun must be used throughout an individual match, unless it becomes mechanically inoperable. In that case a similar handgun may be substituted at the discretion of the league director. The shooter must provide a handgun, 48 rounds of ammunition and 4 magazines, capable of holding 6 rounds each. He may provide a holster, designed for the gun used, and magazine pouches, if he so desires. A lighting device of some type, capable of illuminating the targets is required. Gun mounted lights or lasers are prohibited. Eye & ear protection is required.

All stages of this shoot will be Timed. Targets will not be scored, only verified for hits, misses or excessive hits. Striking the hostage will be assessed a 5 second penalty for each hit. Additional 5 second penalties, per infraction, will be assessed for procedural violations. Timing will be by electronic shooting timer under control of the Range Safety Officer (RSO).
