**Short Description**: This 16-hour course teaches the knowledge, skills and attitude essential to organizing, promoting and teaching NRA's Basic Pistol Shooting course.

**Prerequisite**: Possession of basic firearm safety and shooting skills is a perquisite for certification as an NRA instructor. Prior to the instructor training, candidates complete a precourse questionnaire and demonstrate their firearm background in pre-course assessment exercises. Fully certified NRA instructors must be at least 21 years of age and legally capable of owning a firearm. The NRA has an assistant instructor and a apprentice instructor program for individuals under the age of 21 years old.
