

2018 WISCONSIN STATE INDOOR SMALLBORE RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIP

March 16 + 17, 2018

This will be an Open NRA Indoor Metric Position smallbore rifle match fired from 50 feet on the NRA/USAS-50 target. The latest published NRA Rules will govern. Positions per NRA rule 5.6 (prone), 5.10 (kneeling) and 5.12 (standing). Any rifle per rule 3.2; Any sights per rule 3.7.

While all shooters are encouraged to be members of both the NRA and their home state's association, membership is not required – The tournament is open to any interested competitor.

FEES

Fees include NRA registration fee of \$5.50 and Wisconsin Force registration fee of \$4.00

Across the Board Entry	\$40.00
Junior Entry	\$25.00

A "With Me" credit of \$3.00 is available for bringing new and "retired" (absent from the State Championships for 5 years or more) shooters to the state championship. Both the new or retired shooter and the person bringing them are eligible for this credit. Bring two shooters and claim it twice! Entries must be made at the same time to claim the credit.

MATCH 6, FOUR-PERSON TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

The scores of Match 4 will determine the Wisconsin Team Champion. There must be two teams for an award to be given. An award will be given to the high class A (Master/Expert) team and high class B (Sharpshooter/Marksman) team if there are at least three teams in a class. Entry fee is \$8.00 per team. At least three individuals making up a team must be from the same club or organization to be eligible for awards.

CLASSIFICATION

Competitors will be classified according to the NRA classification system. The shooter's current

Smallbore Metric Position or NRA 3-Position (Indoor) classification will be used. Assigned classifications will be accepted. Shooters who have never fired in a tournament will enter as Tyro competitors (rule 19.3.)

AWARDS

The high Wisconsin resident in Match 4 will be declared Wisconsin Indoor Smallbore Champion and will be presented the State Champion's traveling trophy; the high Wisconsin collegiate shooter in will hold the Mark Winter Memorial traveling trophy; and the high Wisconsin team in Match 6 will receive the State Championship Team traveling trophy for indoor smallbore.

Awards will be presented to the winner of each match and to the high shooter in each class of at least 5 competitors. Classes with less than five competitors will be combined with the next higher class to reach a 5-competitor minimum. Category awards will be given in Match 4.

Possible categories include Ladies, Juniors, Seniors, Collegians and Iron-sight shooters. There must be at least 3 shooters in a category for an award to be given.
